Margaret was born on her grandfather's farm in Baden, Ontario on February 20, 1924. She was the daughter of Ernst B. and Adeline Mueller. She was predeceased by an older sister Mary in infancy.

The family resided with Adeline's parents, Mr. and Mrs. John Ritz, during the early years. The family returned to Manitoba in 1929. Margaret resided in the Sewell District, attending school in Sewell and Morris. The family frequently went to Ontario for the winter, therefore she also attended school in New Hamburg.

Margaret held a permit teaching position during the war, and later she stayed home to care for her mother. After the passing of her mother on April 20, 1952, she moved to Winnipeg and took a business course.

Margaret then worked for a wholesale small wares firm, before working for the Manitoba Civil Service as a secretary, and a number of years as an Estates Manager for the Office of the Public Trustee in the Attorney General's Department.

After her retirement, Margaret cared for her ailing brother Ernie who predeceased her on May 25, 1993, and an elderly aunt.

Margaret enjoyed life and traveling; she was saddened when she could no longer do so.

The funeral service will be held at the Lutheran Church of the Cross in Morris on Monday April 25 at 2:00 p.m. The interment at the Sewell Cemetery will take place at a later date.
